* Rayological Profile

- *Physical-Etheric Ray (either Ray 3 or Ray 7)
 - *Ray 3: robust, stocky, strong; high pain threshold
 - *Ray 7: refined, graceful; measured movements, loves order
- *Emotional Ray (either Ray 2 or Ray 6)
 - *Ray 2: emotionally calm, compassionate, sensitive, easily overwhelmed
 - *Ray 6: reactive, fiery; takes things personally, seeks revenge
- *Mental Ray (either Ray 1, Ray 4, or Ray 5)
 - *Ray 1: firm, stubborn mind; straight to the point; sees larger picture
 - *Ray 4: intuitive, creative mind; indecisive; colorful, exaggerates
 - *Ray 5: careful, deliberate, accurate; logical; thrives on detail

 - *Astrologers: use houses, rulers, aspects, transits and progressions to help you analyze the chart



 - *Or is the personality an impediment to their soul purpose?

* The Ascendant

- *Ascendant is the method soul uses to express its purpose
- *Briefly recap the goals you've mentioned in this paper
 - *Add the vocation, how does this relate to the Asc sign?
- *What are the positive sign qualities to be developed?
- *How much, if any, soul expression does your person exhibit?
 - *How does this match the esoteric keynote for that sign?

* Hypothetical Initiation

- *Initiation 1 Transference from Sacral to the Throat
 - * Indiv is highly intelligent, conscious of dualism, ready to tread the path
 - * Pluto and Vulcan rule the 1st Initiation as the lower vehicles are purified
- *Initiation 2 Transference from Solar Plexus to the Heart
 - * The Soul is stimulating the Ajna and the Heart center is rapidly opening
 - * The individual is learning to control their astral-desire nature
 - * Jupiter, Venus, and Neptune all rule the 2nd Initiation
- *Initiation 3 Transference from Base to the Crown
 - *The mental nature is controlled
 - *Soul control is such that all centers are swept into ordered activity

* Health Problems tied to the Chakras

- *The 7 major centers condition an area of the physical body
- *Awakened centers present
 - *A highly electric nervous system
 - *Vitality when the centers are open and are responsive to energy
 - *There is a well-balanced endocrine system and resistance to disease
- *Uneven development produces problems with the nervous system and glands
 - *Leading to undesirable reactions
 - *Under or over stimulation
 - *Lack of vitality
 - *Inevitably producing disease

* Consciousness and Health Problems

The Seven Major Centres, Consciousness, Glands & Health Problems

Consciousness	Health Problems EP II 535-9.
CROWN CENTRE: Initiate. Master. Dominant after 3rd Initiation. EH 45. It relates man to the Atmic plane and the 1st Will aspect. It provides the soul its point of entry and exit in the body. From the Crown spiritual will is used to synthesise all the other centres in the body, and to transfer all the bodily and psychic forces to the head centre. This is done through the awakening of the base chakra and arousing kundalini which burns all etheric webs between the centres. When this occurs the man is controlled only from above, by the soul. This process is consummated at the 3rd initiation. Although the soul is now working directly through the personality, it is not until the 4th initiation that the Monad takes control and individual experience in the lower worlds is complete. TWM 190	
AJNA CENTRE: Aspirant. Disciple. Mystic. Dominant after 2nd Initiation. "Comes alive preceding passing to the Probationary Path." EP II 304. The Ajna is the seat of personality power and represents the highest form of creative intelligence in man. It is the organ of imagination. 1st degree initiate: The ajna ruled personality is intelligent and effective on the physical plane, but focus is materialistic and selfish. The ajna energies sweep down into the solar plexus and sacral centres. 2nd degree initiate: Later, when the disciple is able to hold the mind "steady in the light", soul energy can flow into the heart centre. Fully functional by the 3rd Initiation. EH 147.	Pituitary gland. Left eye, sinuses, lower brain, nervous system - neuritis, headache, serious eye trouble, nerve difficulties.
THROAT CENTRE: All advanced humanity, The Intelligentsia. Purification of the physical appetites is marked by the transference of energy from the sacral centre to the throat. Individuals focused in the higher centre are becoming mentally creative. This centre provides the entry point for energy from the mental plane.	Thyroid gland. The mouth, tongue, larynx, trachea, bronchial tree, upper lungs, lymphatic system, shoulders, arms, hands, hyperthyroidism.

The Seven Major Centres, Consciousness, Glands & Health Problems

HEART CENTRE: Spiritual people, becomes more dominant after the 1st Initiation but only opens fully at the 4th initiation. The 1st initiation relates man to the buddhic plane and Love-Wisdom. As we evolve and the heart centre begins to awaken under soul impulse, it draws up the energies of the solar plexus, thus controlling the desire nature.	The heart. Arteries, veins, capillaries, lungs, breasts, thymus gland. Heart trouble, vagus nerve, autonomic nervous system, AIDS, cancer, rheumatoid arthritis.
SOLAR PLEXUS CENTRE: Average humanity, and ordinary man. It is related to the astral plane and through it are expressed feelings and desires from the most crude to the subtle. In the average person it works closely with the sacral and base centres, with desires focused on the lower appetites. In more advanced man it gives desire for recognition and for a better quality of life. In the person approaching the 2nd Initiation, it acts as a clearing ground for the energies of the lower centres, which begin to be gathered up by the solar plexus and transferred to the heart centre.	Digestive organs including stomach, pancreas, liver, spleen, gallbladder, bowel, pancreas. Emotional, digestive, nervous, blood stream problems. Most cancers caused by congestion in the solar plexus.
SACRAL CENTRE: "low grade animal type of men". Individuals focused at this very low level are totally intent upon sex and money, and use all creative energy to support these appetites. The sacral centre is related to the four etheric subplanes of the physical plane.	The gonads. Ovaries, testes, hips, knees - unbalanced sexual expression, venereal diseases, AIDS, herpes, genital warts. Over activity of sexual imagination and the sex life.
BASE CENTRE: Individuals focused in the base centre are the primitive, intent upon survival in nature, as this centre is related to the physical plane and gives 'grounding'. It is awakened in its true and final sense at the third initiation. EP II 302.	Adrenals. Kidneys, bladder, genitals - Premature awakening serious nerve/ brain, spine disease, inflamed tissues.







* Chakra and Ray Correlations for Steiner

Chakra	Average Man Non-sacred Ruler	Disciple/Initiate Sacred Ruler	Correlation for Rudolf Steiner
Throat Chakra	Ray 3 Earth	Ray 3 Saturn	With the volume of books he wrote, this chakra of intelligent activity was very active for him. He has his Earth conjunct Saturn in Virgo in his 10 th house.
Heart Chakra	Ray 2 Sun	Ray 2 Jupiter	Ray 2 Soul, demonstrated through Jupiter as one of the rulers of his Piscean Sun.
