## MEDITATION

First, simply visualize this symbol as you say the Great Invocation while sequentially associating the geometry with the words.

- As you imagine the descending lines, try to feel their fohatic energy.
- Once you've linked words and geometry, after many meditations using this symbol, begin to fuse the geometry with the meaning that stands behind the words.
- When the geometry by itself evokes the full import of the words without sounding or even thinking those words, move onto the next section of the Invocation.
- When you are able to evoke the synthetic meaning of every geometric element of the total symbol in sequence without any reference to the words, then begin combining elements until you have a final synthesis.
