It must be remembered that every threeyear period constitutes a new stage of consciousness, just as every seven years brings a renewal of the centers. – *New Era Community*, 79.







The current decade



Sat conj. Asc = Reconfiguration of the Identity

- 1968-69: The People's Republic of China replaced Taiwan in the Security Council (October 71).
- 1997-98: Kofi Annan's "quiet revolution" of the UN: a downsizing of the administrative and bureaucratic structure but not a reform of the political structure (July 1997).
- 2027: Institutional reforms: limitations of the Security Council and the General Assembly, clear definitions of the Secretary General's tasks, etc.

Neptune cycle (165 y) = Anchoring the *Infinite Love of the*Spirit of Peace (Human Rights and Freedoms)

- Nep sqr. Nep (1987): Peacekeeping forces as a whole received the Nobel Peace Prize (1988). The maximum peak of approval of the UN.
- Nep (progr.) D → Rx (2022): Russia used its veto power to block a resolution against its invasion of Ukraine, highlighting a significant weakness in the UNSC's effectiveness. Inability to maintain peace results in a lower level of approval.
- Nep opp. Nep (2027): A new opportunity to safeguard Human Rights and Freedoms.

Jup conj. Jup (Jupiter's Return, 12 y) = UN's Ideals

- 1969: The International Labour Organization received the Nobel Peace Prize for improving fraternity and peace among nations, pursuing decent work and justice for workers, and providing technical assistance to other developing nations.
- 1981: The UN High Commissioner for Refugees was awarded the **Nobel Peace Prize** in 1954 and 1981, becoming one of only two recipients to win the prize twice.
- 1992-93: Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil (1992). A key achievement of this conference was the establishment of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).

Jup conj. Jup (Jupiter's Return) = UN's Ideals

- 2004-2005: The International Atomic Energy Agency (which reports to the UN) won the **Nobel Peace Prize** in 2005.
- 2016: Alongside addressing global challenges, the UN has worked to boost its accountability and democratic legitimacy by engaging more with civil society and building a global constituency. To improve transparency, in 2016 the organization held its first public debate among candidates for Secretary General.
- 2028: A new opportunity to expand the UN's ideals.

Uranus cycle (84 y) = Values for the New Era / Anchoring the Liberating Light of Lord Buddha (Sustainable Development)

- Ura sqr. Ura (1965): Amendments to the United Nations Charter expanded the number of permanent and non-permanent members of the Security Council, as well as the number of members of the Economic and Social Council.
- Ura opp. Ura (1985): The UN Charter's 40th anniversary. The period from 23 to 30 June 1985 was declared 'UN Days' in San Francisco.
- **Ura sqr. Ura (2007):** The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change received the **Nobel Peace Prize** for contributions to the understanding of climate change.
- Ura conj. Ura (2029-30): Post-2030 Agenda.

Pluto Cycle (248 y) = Anchoring the *Indefinable Power of the Avatar of Synthesis* (Peace and Security)

- Plu sxt. Plu (1976-77): The General Assembly established the Joint Inspection Unit to seek out inefficiencies, waste, and corruption within the UN system.
- Plu sqr. Plu (1987-88): The number of adopted Security Council resolutions more than doubled, and the peacekeeping budget increased more than tenfold (1988-2000).
- Plu tri. Plu (1999-2000): Expansion of the international interventions authorized by the UN in cooperation with other international organizations working for peace.
- Plu opp. Plu (2030-31): A new opportunity to ensure Peace and Security.

Progressed Moon Cycle (28 y)

Human Rights and Freedoms Cycle:

- 1956: Moon conj. Sun (New Moon) The creation of the United Nations Emergency Force (UNEF), the first United Nations peacekeeping force. (Suez Canal Crisis)
- 1971: Moon opp. Sun (Full Moon) United Nations Military Observer Group in India and Pakistan (UNMOGIP) observing the ceasefire in Jammu and Kashmir. (Bangladesh War)

Progressed Moon Cycle (28 y)

Peace and Security Cycle:



- 1986: Moon conj. Sun (New Moon) The UN declared 1986 the International Year of Peace, aiming to promote Peace and Security.
- 2000: Moon opp. Sun (Full Moon) The Millennium Summit brought together world leaders at UN headquarters to approve the Millennium Declaration, a milestone that laid the foundation for the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) with goals for 2015.

Progressed Moon Cycle (28 y)

Sustainable Development Cycle:

- 2015-16: Moon conj. Sun (New Moon: Start of New Cycle) The Sustainable Development Goals were launched in 2015 to succeed the Millennium Development Goals.
- 2030: Moon opp. Sun (Full Moon: The Maximum point of the Cycle) Review of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. Post-2030 Agenda.

Sat conj. Ic = UN's Role in Land Disputes

- **1945:** Creation of the **State of Israel** (1947).
- 1974: The UN Buffer Zone in Cyprus is a demilitarized zone, patrolled by the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP) that divides the Country into two zones controlled by two different factions.
- 2003-04: The US invaded Iraq despite failing to pass a UN Security Council resolution for authorization, prompting a new round of questioning of the UN's effectiveness.
- 2033: Reconfiguration of the world's frontiers.

Saturn cycle (29.5 y) = Responsibility as a result of the Soul's contact

- Sat opp. Sat (1961): The UN's membership increased significantly due to the influx of newly independent nations through decolonization.
- Sat conj. Sat (1975): The General Assembly passed a resolution declaring that Zionism is a form of racism and racial discrimination.
- Sat opp. Sat (1990): The reversal in 1991 of the previous resolution was due to global political changes.
- Sat conj. Sat (2004-05): The UN faced accusations that its recently ended Oil-for-Food Programme had suffered from widespread corruption.
- Sat opp. Sat (2019-20): The COVID-19 Global Humanitarian Response Plan.
- Sat conj. Sat (2034): New responsibilities under the Post-2030 Agenda.

Nep conj. Angles = UN's Spiritualization/Dissolution

- Nep conj. Dsc (1951-1952): The UN faced some of its earliest existential challenges: as it learned to balance its universalist ideals with the realities of great-power rivalry, such as in the Korean War and the Cold War deadlock over membership and disarmament. The UN's permanent headquarters (Meditation Room) was established in New York in 1952.
- Nep conj. Mc (1988-1989): Peacekeeping forces as a whole received the Nobel Peace Prize (1988). In the early 1990s, the UN faced multiple crises in Somalia, Haiti, Mozambique, and the countries of the former Yugoslavia, with poor results.
- Nep conj. Asc (2033-34): Spiritualization/Dissolution of the organization.

UN's Reconfiguration

• Progressed Sun enters Aquarius (2034): A genuinely inclusive, multilateral, and humanitarian organization.
